The Flower Show is held at the Pennsylvania Convention Center on Arch St between 11th & 12th Streets.

Flower Show Theme: Experience one of the most diverse displays of plants under one roof. America’s premier flower show presents Holland: Flowering the World. A mosaic of gardens, canals and bridges connect the old with the new in Dutch and American floral and garden design. Delight in a whole new color palette and selection of spectacular blooming bulbs. Immerse yourself in the innovation, art and horticulture of the Netherlands.

Where to Eat: Food can be purchased at the Flower Show throughout the Pennsylvania Convention Center. There are Snack Bars at the rear of the main exhibit hall, and full dining services located on Level 3 above the exhibition halls in the Overlook Café. You will also find numerous restaurants in the area immediately surrounding the Convention Center, including Reading Terminal Market and in nearby Chinatown.

Free Re-entry: Visitors can re-enter the show on the same day for free. Need to have hand stamped.

Handicap Accessibility: The Pennsylvania Convention Center is a handicap accessible building. Elevators are available to guests who require them. Wheelchairs are available for rent on a first-come, first-served basis.

Visitor Suggestions:

- Dress for the occasion - There’s a lot to see, so comfortable shoes are a must. Dress in layers as it can get chilly on the Show floor.
